

Modular Convenience Counters (MCC) Cold - cleaning (monthly)



Step 1
IMPORTANT: turn off the MCC by pressing the O on the 3 switches. Pull the plug.



Step 9, only Full Serve model or Self-Serve with doors
Clean the front glass (doors). Model with doors: also clean the back of the doors.



Step 17
Now tilt the outermost door outwards along the guiding pin, so you can clean it on the other side.



Step 2
Clean the top glass pane.



Step 10, only Full Serve model
Lift and hold the top glass while tilting/lowering the front glass until it can move no further. Lower the top glass back in place.



Step 18
Then slide both doors to the right until the innermost door's slot aligns with the guiding pin.



Step 3
Lift and hold the top glass pane while cleaning it on the inside.



Step 11, only Full Serve model
Clean the back of the front glass.



Step 19
Tilt both doors outwards to clean the inside of the innermost door and the back of the shelves.

Follow the above steps in reverse order to return both doors to their original positions. Remember to align the slots with the guiding pins first!



Step 4
Lift and hold the top glass pane while removing the transparent air guide pane for cleaning.



Step 12
Clean the shelves inside the unit.



Step 20
Unscrew the condenser cover with a screwdriver.



Step 5
Clean the transparent air guide pane and place it back.

Do not use detergents and other cleaning products that may damage polycarbonate.



Step 13
Also clean the aluminum plates on the bottom of the unit and the space below them.



Step 21
Clean the condenser using a long-haired soft brush and a vacuum cleaner.



Step 6, only Self-Serve model
Also clean each of the air box compartments before putting back the transparent air guide pane. It's imperative to maintain both hygiene and transparency on the inside and outside of the top air box.



Step 14, only Full Serve model
Lift and hold the top glass while closing the front glass until you hear a snap. Gently lower the top glass back in place.



Step 7
Slide the double-glass side pane towards the front, along the top guide and bottom guiding rails. Clean both sides while holding it.

 Don't slide it past the top guide, as that might cause the side pane to tilt and drop.



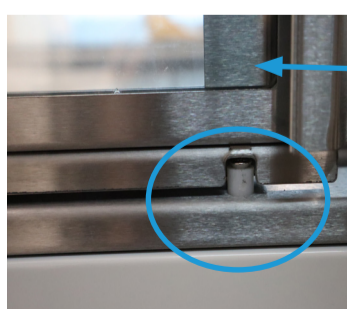
Step 15
Clean the back doors on the outside.

Solid back models: simply clean the outside (if accessible) and inside of the back.



Step 8
To clean the guiding rails the side pane can be removed entirely.

The transparent sides of the side pane should face forward and up when sliding it back in position. Also make sure it fits into the vertical U-profile at the back.



Step 15
To clean the back doors on the inside and the back of the shelves, please follow the next steps.

First slide the right (outermost) door open until its slot aligns with the guiding pin

Daily Cleaning

- Clean the inside of the unit with hot water and a sustainable cleaner. Do not use excess water; this could cause the evaporation tray to overflow.
- Then wipe with wet cloth to remove detergent.

Weekly Cleaning

- Clean the outside of the unit using a small amount of hot water, a mild cleanser and a soft brush or sponge. After cleaning, dry with a cloth.
- Treat cleaned surfaces with an antibacterial agent. Rub dry with a soft cloth or paper towel.
